DAY 01.

DELH - COCHIN BY FLIGHT



COCHIN

Welcome to the captivating and charming city of Cochin that is breathtakingly beautiful. Cochin is also referred to as Kochi. On the western coast of India Cochin is also termed the Queen of the Arabian Sea. The city of Cochin besides the beauty of nature happens to be the commercial and industrial capital of its state- the God's own country Kerala. While at Cochin you must visit the Fort Cochin that reveals the European heritage of the city. Then there is the Santa

Cruz Basilica that happens to be a landmark of Cochin and a major tourist attraction.

Day will be at your leisure to relax and in the evening walk around the Old city of Fort Cochin.

DAY 02.

IN COCHIN

Breakfast at hotel.

Full day tour of the satellite towns of Kochi (Cochin) and Emakulam comprises of visits to the Dutch Palace, the Jewish Synagogue - (which remains closed on Fridays) St. Francis Church and the Santa Cruz Basilica. While driving along the coastline, at the Harbour's mouth, one can also view the unique and still-in-use "Chinese Fishing Nets" which were introduced by the Chinese traders in the 14th Century. The tour ends in the Fort Kochi area where you can walk through the historical Dutch and Portuguese buildings. Some parts of this nearly 500-year-old Fort are still amazingly well preserved.



Evening enjoy the Kathakali Dance show:

Kathakali Dance Show. Witness India's most spectacular Dance Drama based on stories from Ramayana and Mahabharata. The dancers are elaborately made up with paint and masks, accompanied with drummers and musicians.

DAY 03.

COCHIN – MUNNAR BY SURFACE (139 Kms / 04 Hrs)

Breakfast at hotel



Late morning depart Cochin for Munnar. On the way to Munnar enjoy beautiful streams small water falls, Rubber, Pepper cardamom and Tea plantations and thick forests, God has blessed his own country with incomparable beauty on arrival at Munnar check in to Hotel.

Day at leisure to relax in the Tea Valley and enjoy the Nature with ultimate Landscape.

Morning visit Tea Plantation & Tea Museum:

Munnar will give you an unforgettable mental pleasure by covering - Mattupetty Lake & Dam, Echo Point, Kundale Lake, Blossom Garden, Rajamalai – offering a spectacular view, Eravikulam Wildlife sanctuary, home of Nilgiry Thar(very rare mountain goat), considering the ecological faunal, floral, geomorphological and zoological significant & Tea Plantation. Later return to the hotel for overnight stay.

Evening enjoy the walk around the Market in Munnar and you may like to shop the different kinds of Tea which is famous across the country as well as in the World.

If time permit proceed to visit Erivakulam National Park which is world wide famous for it species of Nilgiri Thar and other species of Exotic Plants.

Later return back to hotel in Munnar.

DAY 05. MUNNAR- PERIYAR (145 kms/ 4 hrs)

Breakfast at hotel

After visiting Munnar depart Munnar for Thekkady (Periyar), Travel by a chauffer driven car making stops on the way at your wish for taking some interesting pictures of the rubber and spice plantations.



THEKKADY (PERIYAR)

Thekkady is a tiny hamlet on the periphery of the Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary, in Kerala. The Sanctuary allows visitors an opportunity to view elephants, wild boar, deer and other wild animals while cruising on the Periyar Lake. Visitors can also commune with nature by embarking on a jungle trek with a forest warden. Thekkady is the perfect place to get away from it all for a day or two.

Later visit Spice Plantation and spice market where the spices are direct from the field to shops. Do not forget get purchased few

packets of cardamom, Clove and Muskat, Cumin and Anis which are fresh preserved.

On arrival, check-in at Hotel.

DAY 06.

PERIYAR – ALLEPPEY (145 Kms/04 Hrs)

Morning enjoy boat cruise (optional) return hotel for breakfast,

Later depart Thekkady (Periyar) for Alleppey.

Alleppey – referred to as the **"Venice of the East"** by travellers from across the world, Alappuzha is a district of immense natural beauty. Caressed by the Arabian Sea in the west and a vast network of lakes, lagoons and freshwater rivers criss crossing it, this backwater country shelters some unique animal and bird life.

House boat is the another high light of this place...!!!
